





required to align features.



Raise or lower panels to align features. Pre-drill and screw in place, packing out to suit. INITIAL FILLING AND SHAPING



Use a grouting bag for the initial application of the jointing compound to cover joints and fixing locations.

THE DETAILING

EXAMPLE DETAILS



CORNERS - Raise or lower panels to align features. Mark position of corner and cut to form mitre.

Fix panels, leaving approx. 5mm gap. Apply the jointing compound and shape to suit.



FINISHING EXPOSED EDGES - If panel end is exposed, use the jointing compound to fill panel edge and shape to create the stone end.



INTRODUCE THE FINAL TEXTURE

Shape the jointing compound to suit as it begins to go firm. The putty knife can also be used to apply the filler if required.

THE BLENDING PROCESS



Introduce final texture to the jointing compound with a brush moistened with the cleaner.



Leave for 24 hours. Sparingly apply colour solutions. Rag off, and then blend with surrounding area.
